

The NCAA Readers Become Leaders Program aims to help teachers who are dealing with a literacy crisis that affects children of all demographics. Educational data have shown that if reading is below grade level by the fourth grade, students are four times more likely to drop out of school. Readers Become Leaders was created to encourage children to explore their talents, which lays a foundation for future educational goals, such as attending college.

In 2019, the Fort Worth Sports Commission teamed up with the NCAA Readers Become Leaders program and the Fort Worth ISD to implement the program in grades K-5 as part of the NCAA Women's Gymnastics Championships hosted in Fort Worth. In five years, the program has seen more than 92,000 students read more than 101 million minutes. The program is back again this year and the incentives and benefits to the students and participating schools has never been better.

HOW IT WORKS

- Elementary schools sign up for the program using the app Helper Helper.
- Students log their minutes read every day and turn those minutes into their teacher at the end of the week.
- The teacher totals their minutes for the classroom and enters the total onto the app.
- Weekly totals are updated and communicated to the participating schools.
- At the end of the 10 week program the top two schools from each division are invited to the open practice of the NCAA Women's Gymnastics Championships and the winners are announced.
